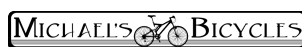

CRITERIUM COURSE: Challenging 1.2 mi three-turn counterclockwise course with an uphill finish. 60 feet of gain per lap. Finish is approximately 800m from final turn. Reverse direction from 2017.
